¹ For the purposes of this study, any reference to Saldanha Bay includes Big Bay and Small Bay, Langebaan Lagoon, the islands and the immediate surrounding areas.

² Although the EIA regulations in terms of the ECA have been repealed by EIA regulations in terms of the National Environmental Management Act (NEMA) as from 3 July 2006, this application is being dealt with in terms of the ECA, as the EIA process was started prior to the new regulations coming into effect.

⁵ **Ship motion definitions are as follows:** Heave: is the linear vertical (up/down) motion. Sway: is the linear lateral (side-to-side) motion. Surge: is the linear longitudinal (front/back) motion; Roll: is when the vessel rotates about the longitudinal (front/back) axis. Pitch: is when the vessel rotates about the transverse (side-to-side) axis. Yaw: is when the vessel rotates about the vertical (up-down) axis (http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Ship_motions).
